

## Indonesia East Kalimantan blue swimming crab - bottom gillnet & pot/trap

### Overview

#### FIP Description

The fishery is located in the East Kalimantan province of Indonesia, Fishery management area (FMA) 713. The Units of Assessment (UoAs) were the target species Blue Swimming Crab (BSC) *Portunus pelagicus* (known locally as rajungan) caught using collapsible baited traps (called bubus) and gillnets by registered fishing vessels < 5 GT off the coastal waters of Jenebora and Tanjung Jumalai. This fishery is a traditional fishery that demonstrates strong cooperation with Aruna and a commitment to the key principles of the MSC standard.


