

Term of Reference

Background

Socio-economic aspects are one of the important aspects in development, especially tuna fisheries. Currently, the Harvest Strategy (HS) document has been signed by the Minister of KKP in July 2023 and will be integrated into the Tuna-Cakalang-Tongkol Fisheries Management Plan (RPP-TCT) automatically because it has been mentioned in the RPP-TCT document.

The Tuna Fishery Harvest Strategy is a comprehensive framework that will outline the management actions required for a fishery to achieve its objectives, one such objective being socio-economic objectives. The Harvest Strategy itself has been identified by members of the working group as a system in itself that focuses more on biological aspects and to monitor the impact of HS implementation, the working group agreed that socio-economic aspects are the main thing to monitor.

In April 2023, the HS Tuna Fisheries Socio-Economic Working Group (Sosec Working Group) held its second meeting where the meeting discussed what indicators were prioritized, what data needed to be collected and who could play a role in collecting the data.

As a follow-up to the second meeting, Yayasan IPNLF Indonesia (YII), a member of the Tuna Consortium, will invite stakeholders of the Sosec Working Group to discuss the continuation of the initiative to develop socio-economic indicators for monitoring HS Tropical Tuna in the archipelagic waters of the Republic of Indonesia.

Meeting Objectives

This meeting aimed to develop an initial draft on data collection for the selected socio-economic indicators and develop an implementation plan.

Output

At the end of this workshop, a data collection plan and implementation plan were made available and agreed upon by the working group members.
