The Eastern Pacific Longline Large Pelagics FIP (Martec) fishery targets yellowfin tuna (*Thunnus albacares*) and mahi mahi (*Coryphaena hippurus*). The 150 longline vessels are flagged to Costa Rica and fish on the high seas and within the Costa Rica EEZ. The fishery is managed by the Costa Rican Institute of Fisheries and Aquaculture (INCOPESCA) and regionally the Inter-American Tropical Tuna Commission (IATTC).

FisheryProgress Social Requirements FisheryProgress has developed new social requirements to address concerns regarding social and labour issues in seafood supply chains. All fisheries must have a grievance mechanism in place and display that they are making all fishers aware of their rights. Martec is working with Key Traceability on these points but wanted to check if INCOPESCA is working on these topics too?

Observer Data

Historic human observer data

It is extremely important we get an independent understanding of the impact the fishery has. To do this, we need to obtain historic human observer data. Is it possible to receive this? We are happy to have this in any format. It is vital to understand the ETP impacts especially.

Getting observers on vessels

We would love to be able to work with you to increase human observer coverage on vessels. Is there a way we can increase the number of human observers on FIP vessels?

Electronic Monitoring

Along with global leaders TNC, we are exploring rolling out a phased approach of an EM pilot. This will likely be 2 cameras on a selection of vessels recording 24/7. A statistically significant number of sets will then be analysed as to if a human observer was on board.

Objectives

- Understand current observer programme in Costa Rica
- Obtain approval of historic human observer data
- Explain the FIPs EM plans and understand INCOPESCA's interests

Principle 3 Management

Fishery-specific objectives, failed within the preassessment and Decision-making processes, Compliance and enforcement and Monitoring and management performance evaluation all received conditional passes when assessed. This preassessment was conducted remotely, in English so naturally could have missed points which would have scored these a pass.

We would love to be able to share with you the evidence required to make these passes, if you could then fill them with anything you have. If you are lacking the evidence, we would love to be able to work with you to address these gaps to improve Costa Rican fisheries.

Advocacy / Principle 1 asks

Ahead of the IATTC meeting we, as a FIP, will create advocacy letters to be sent to INCOPESCA and IATTC detailing what our asks and requirements are that need to be addressed in the meeting.

This includes developing HCRs and harvest strategies for mahi and tuna species, improving observer coverage and management of ETP species. Does this align with INCOPESCA's views?
