To whom it may concern:

We hereby inform that below mentioned vessels, which operate in the Indian Ocean and Atlantic Ocean belong to the Vessel Owners' Association **ANABAC**, have 100% observer coverage (human observer or Electronic Monitoring (EM)) in compliance with their public Code of Good Practices, no finning events have been detected by observers onboard.

These observers embark under both the European Data Collection Framework and the scope of the common agreement for the application of the Code of Good Practices established by the ship-owners associated to ANABAC. AZTI acts as an independent verifier, analyzing the collected data by the different observers and EM to assess the level of application of these good practices. The good practices defined in this agreement comprise the use of non-entangling FADs as well as the application of best release operations for sensitive fauna, among others. The **intentional retention of any shark is forbidden**, being strict and inflexible regarding the practice of shark finning. All shark fins must be naturally attached to any unintentionally retained shark.

These data include scientific data collection on tuna purse seiner fishing activity as stipulated by the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission (IOTC), International Commission for the Conservation of the Atlantic Tuna (ICCAT) and/or by the European Data Collection Framework (*Commission Regulation (EC) No 665/2008*) and evidence that no finning events have been detected by observers onboard.
