The Multispecies Trawl Fishery Improvement Project in Vung Tau intends to develop a Fishery Management plan and tools for stakeholders, specifically the Fishery Department of Ba Ria Vung Tau, to be able to guarantee a more sustainable fishery in the provincial waters.

Currently, in January 2023, Kim Delta is preparing next steps for fisheries data collection in Ba Ria - Vung Tau province.

5. Remarks

- Ms. Hien from IUCN Vietnam said the Directorate of Fisheries is planning to ban trawling due to its negative impacts on marine habitats and ETPs. The first question here is in how many years will this be possible? Ba Ria - Vung Tau alone has 1,452 trawlers, banning the fishery will lead to disturbances in livelihoods for many thousands of fishermen, so it takes time and a route to train fishermen with new occupations, facilitating their livelihood conversion processes. If the scenario of a complete ban on trawling is not possible, or it takes a longer time to gradually reduce the number of vessels, then the next question will be what criteria for trawlers to continue fishing? It can be said that, in the next five or ten years, trawling will not disappear, and FIP Vung Tau, through its fisheries co-management team, is expected to help the province's fisheries management agency to find solutions to minimise the negative impacts of the trawl fishery on marine habitats and facilitate the conversion livelihood of fishermen.
