Objective: This meeting aims to review the stock status, current harvest control rules, and harvest strategy and improve them in collaboration with an interinstitutional team.

Meeting Bullets:

- Create a scientific publication focusing on the assessment of brown shrimp and blue shrimp stocks in the region.
- Explore the current status of the fishery and pinpoint potential contributions to resource management by analyzing the life history of the species.
- Suggest methodologies, built upon existing model assumptions, to assess alternative approaches.
- Distinguish between environmental factors and fishing impacts on stock levels.
- Assess the recruitment/survival ratio to establish the replacement level as a reference point.
- Discuss the theory of basal recruitment in organisms with short life cycles.
- Contribute publicly to enhancing fisheries management and decision-making processes.
