

RISK-BASED FRAMEWORK TRAINING

Marine Stewardship Council (MSC) collaboration with the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries of Republic of Indonesia held Risk-based Framework (RBF) training on 11-17 May 2023. The activity, which was held online, was attended by several relevant stakeholders including government, academics and associations including APRI. The training was opened by Mr. Hirmen Syofyanto as Program Director of MSC Indonesia. Technically, this training begins with independent learning interspersed with presentation sessions by presenters from MSC Global. Group assignment sessions and discussions with work results were also carried out to explore participants' potential and knowledge during the training, and ended with an independent final test. This risk-based framework training is quite important, especially for blue swimming crab fisheries, where the blue swimming crab fisherman is a small-scale fishery. This step is an important effort to maintain the future of Indonesian fisheries in a sustainable manner. Through this training, it is hoped that APRI and other stakeholders can increase the capacity in implementing a risk-based framework for the Indonesian blue swimming crab fishery as a step in implementing sustainable management.
















