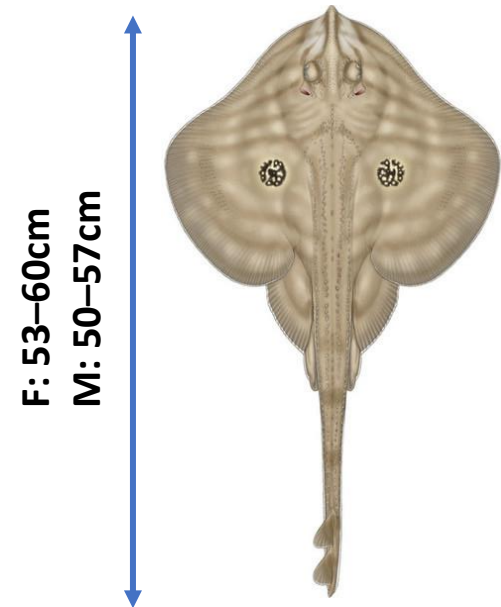


Cuckoo ray *Leucoraja naevus*

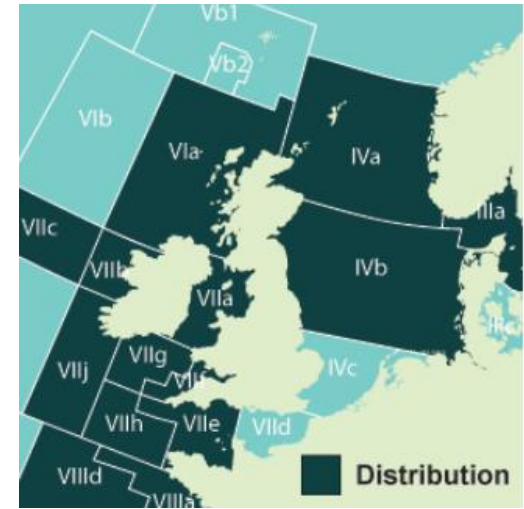


ID tips:

- Large black and yellow eyespot on each pectoral fin.
- Light grey to brown dorsal surface
- 3–5 rows of thorns along tail joining to 2 median rows on trunk

Management & status:

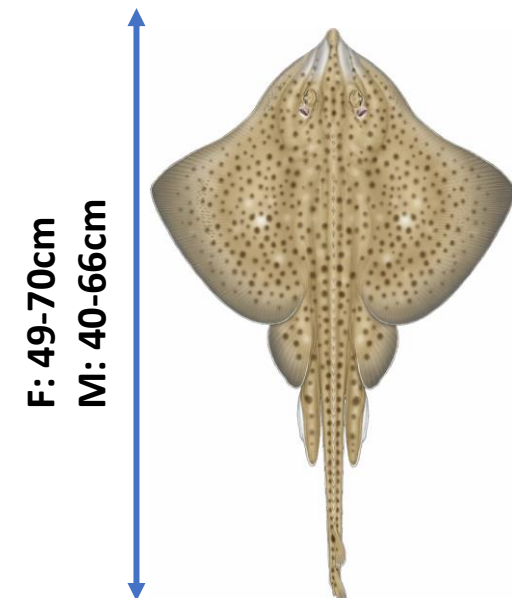
- IUCN Red List: Least Concern
- Subject to regulations for commercial vessels

Spotted ray *Raja montagui*



ID tips:

- Ring of dark spots on each wing giving the appearance of an 'eyespot' sometimes present
- Top-side pale grey-brown to yellow
- Numerous dark spots which do not extend to very edge of disc

Management & status:

- IUCN Red List: Least Concern
- Subject to regulations for commercial vessels
