



## COORDINATION AND ASSISTANCE ON VESSEL REGISTRATION

Vessel registration continue to be conducted such as in Rembang and Pamekasan. On January 2025, some of the fishing vessels were successfully measured as part of the requirements for obtaining the vessel licensing document. The fishermen fully supported the process by temporarily halting their fishing activities. This initiative not only facilitates legal compliance and improves access to government support but also enhances safety at sea and strengthens the government's capacity for maritime oversight and data collection related to small-scale fishing vessels. On August 2025, the field support team facilitated the renewal process for vessel license document belonging to local fishermen.



On June 2025, APRI continues to strive to contribute by fully supporting vessel registration. APRI, along with one of its members, PT. Sumber Kemenangan Sejahtera Abadi (SKSA), held a meeting with the Tanjung Pakis Fisheries Management Unit (KSOP) in Lamongan Regency. One of the topics discussed was collaboration in supporting the competitiveness of sustainable and traceable blue swimming crab fishery products so that this downstreaming can continue to support the economy of coastal communities. Following the meeting, APRI member PT. SKSA immediately coordinated with the Tanjung Pakis Fisheries Management Unit (KSOP) in Lamongan Regency, the Tuban Marine and Fisheries Agency Branch in Paciran, the Lamongan Marine and Fisheries Agency, the Fisheries Association (Fisher Community), and all stakeholders to fulfill the vessel registration document.
