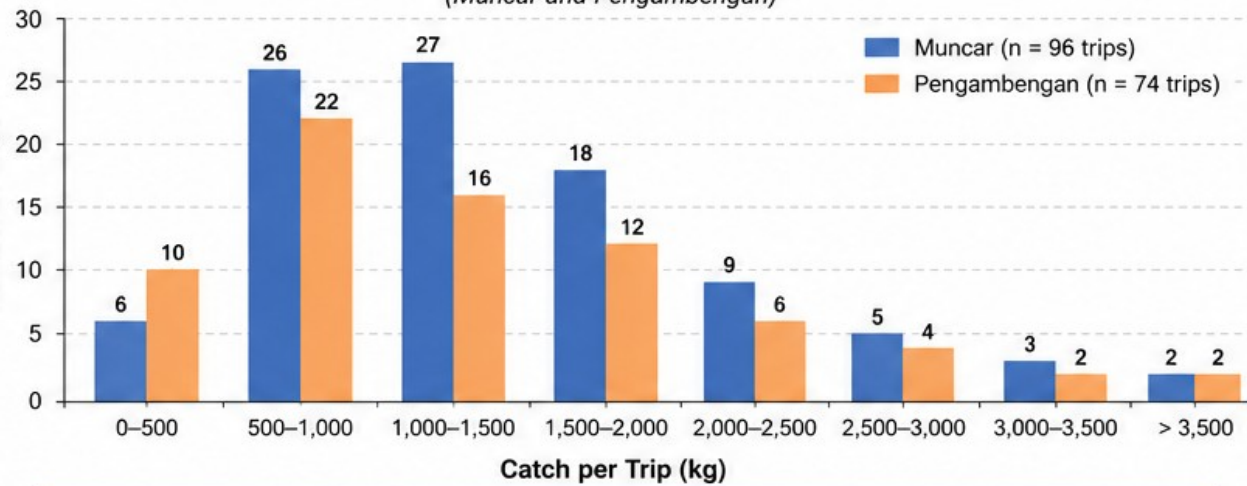


FIGURE 1. Distribution of Catch per Trip (kg)

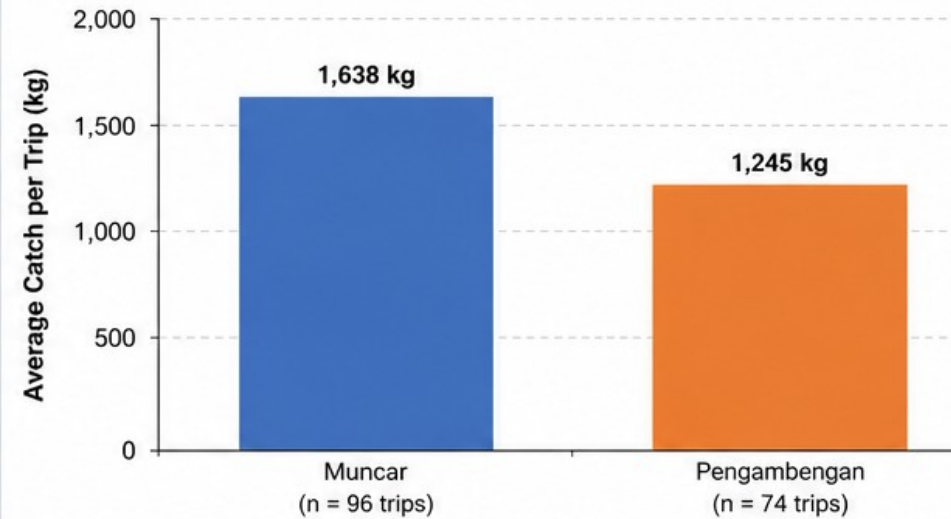
Operational data collected from February to April 2026

FIGURE 2. Average Catch per Trip (kg) by Location

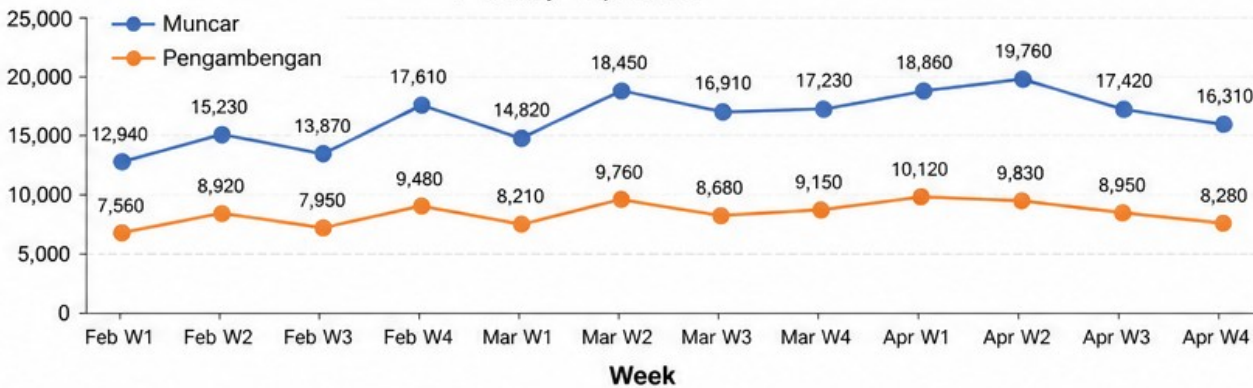
February – April 2026

FIGURE 3. Total Catch Over Time (kg)

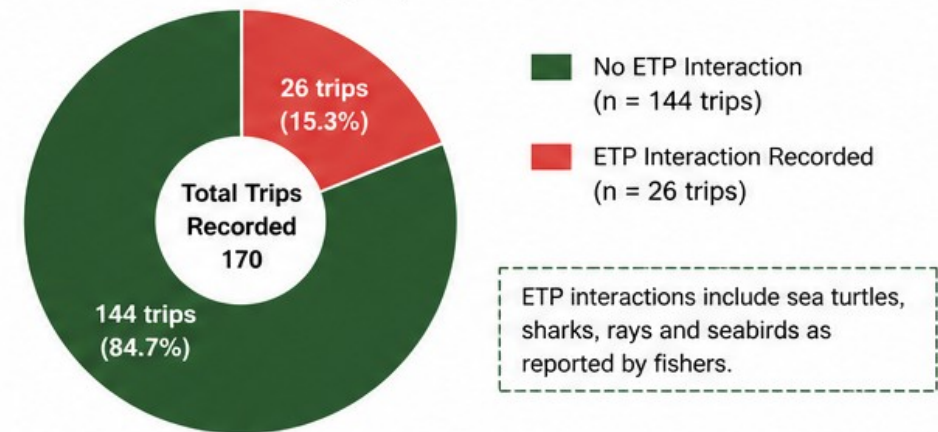
February – April 2026
