



Activity Report:

Another Batch of Installation of ALON VMS to Vessels Enrolled Under the FIP and Training on the ALON System

Date: March 13, 2026

Venue: Kablacan, Maasim to General Santos City, and vice versa

Participants:

The participants are composed of captains, crew members, and key stakeholders who are actively engaged throughout the training and installation activities. Their involvement demonstrated a strong commitment to strengthening monitoring and safety practices within the handline fishery.

Activity Objective:

The primary objective of the activity was to enhance vessel monitoring, traceability, and onboard safety by installing ALON tracking devices on selected handline fishing vessels. The activity also aimed to build the capacity of vessel owners, captains, and crew members through hands-on training on the proper operation, maintenance, and basic troubleshooting of the tracking units. In addition, the initiative promoted the use of digital monitoring tools such as NFC cards to log fishing trips and record catch information, thereby improving data accuracy and supporting compliance with fisheries management regulations.

Activity Highlights:

1. During this batch, six (6) handline vessels successfully underwent installation of ALON tracking units, while two (2) units were replaced and one (1) unit was reinstalled due to malfunction.
2. Each vessel was also provided with NFC cards for crew members to digitally log their fishing trips.
3. The installation team conducted onboard mounting, configuration, and signal testing to ensure that all units were properly installed and capable of

transmitting accurate real-time data.

4. The activity also included a training and orientation session where participants received demonstrations on vessel monitoring, safety notifications, and data reporting, further strengthening their understanding of the importance of the ALON system in fisheries monitoring and management.
